**Min 233/ Dec/11. To Consider the Council's Budget for the Year 2012-13**

The Committee examined every aspect of the Council's income and expenditure.

The Committee was keen to support the community events it sponsors while still maintaining a tight control on expenditure.

The committee decided to recommend an increase in the Christmas lights budget from £5,000 to £ 8,000 to replace and provide some additional lights. It was hoped that this will attract more visitors to the Town.

An additional £500 was recommended to the Summer events in Penlan Park to include funds to celebrate the Queen's Jubilee.

Under the new grants available for Heritage and landscape projects, the Committee recommended that £1,000 be made available for the match funding of an application to be made by the Council.

It was proposed by Cllr Ros Bellamy and seconded by Cllr David Williams that the Council recommend an increase to the budget of 2% . This would mean a budget for the year 2012-13 of £ 50,086. All were in favour.
