6101: Apologies: None Received

6102: Police Matters. Crime Report. Generally Crime is low. In the previous month in Llandeilo there had been 2 minor assaults, 1 burglary and 2 incidences of shoplifting, 1 Car had been stolen and there were incidences of damage to motor vehicles. There had been 2 serious fatal car accidents.

The citings for the C. C. T. V. cameras had been agreed.

The Council requested of Sgt Jones if it was possible to access the Police Database and derive a list of all accidents in recent years on Rhosmaen Street from Fairfach to the roundabout junction with the A40. Sgt Jones said he would find out if he could.

The Council informed Sgt Jones of their plan to place accident/incident reports in shops in order to begin to collect information about all incidents on Rhosmaen Street and to encourage people to report them.

The Mayor thanked Sgt Jones on behalf of the Council and Sgt Jones left the meeting.

6108: The Railings and the Benches. The benches had now been replaced and their upgrade had been particularly successful. Quotations were still being sort regarding replacing the benches with ones closely matching the railings.

The Technical Officer had obtained a quotation work for an embossed Llandeilo Fawr Coat of Arms on a notice telling of the Council's role in putting up the railings, approx £600. The Council was in favour, but would like further quotes for a variety of sizes to consider.
