**5876:** Planning Matters:

The Council had received one letter notifying the granting of planning permission - TG/02979. \_ Permission granted for the development of a Touring Caravan site. The Council had received 2 notification of the refusal of Planning Permission - TG/04669 - Permission refused for Barclays bank new Cash-point Machine TG/04636 - permission refused for development at Frondeg.

The Council had received notification of the proposal for Tree works at 6 New Road - The Council had no objection to this proposal.

The Council had received a Notification of Transfer of Licences for The Cottage Inn. Clerk to acknowledge receipt, but to note that this is not in the Council's Boundaries. Send Copies to Llangethen Community Council.

**5877:** Transportation and Lighting Matters: The issue of the Swimming Pool had been raised in a letter from a member of the Public currently needing to travel to

Llandoverly for Physio- Therapy. It was agreed that the proposed new swimming pool was a vitally important development.

The Clerk to write a letter to the head of Leisure and Life-Long Learning with copies to the Head at Tregib stating the Council feels it is important to move on this development and stating that the Council would be willing to have members on any Committee for the progression of this development. The Council also feels that it should be kept up to date with all developments.

The Traffic in Bridge Street - This issue was raised again. The traffic at peak hours here is particularly bad, and there had been a serious accident at this site.

Clerk to write to T. Sage regarding parking on both sides of the road, loading at peak times and general safety issues regarding this piece of road.

**5878: Correspondence:** A letter had been received in response to the Clerk's letter regarding the Toilets at Ffairfach. This letter stated that Llandeilo Town Council was welcome to take over the running of these toilets. The toilets are NOT within our boundaries.

The Council feels strongly that these toilets are a valuable resource about to be lost. The response to the letter stating this is nonsense as the Llandeilo Fawr Town Council could not take over the running of these facilities. Cllr Day to take the issue to the Press.
